

Paying With Debit vs. Credit.

Understanding the difference.

Debit cards and credit cards have a lot in common: They are a convenient alternative to cash; they are accepted at many of the same places; and they are issued by a financial institution. However, the features of debit cards and credit cards are quite different, and it's to your advantage to understand how, when and why to use each one.

How a debit card works:

A debit card functions like a plastic check.

At the time of purchase, the money in your checking account is used to fund the purchase, so there are no future payments or finance charges, provided there is sufficient money in your account. Generally, you'll need to enter your PIN to complete the transaction, which provides added security in case your card is lost or stolen.



It is beneficial to use a debit card if:

- You want to limit spending to the funds you have available.
- You want to avoid interest charges and late-payment fees.
- You want to withdraw cash during the transaction.

How a credit card works:

A credit card functions like a loan — you are borrowing funds from your available line of credit. Interest accrues on the outstanding balance and must be repaid in addition to the balance. To avoid any interest charges, you'll need to pay your credit card bill in full every month. Some credit cards, including those at Bethpage, require a PIN for added security.



It is beneficial to use a credit card if:

- You want to build your credit rating by using your card responsibly.
- You want to make a larger purchase and pay it over time on a schedule that fits your needs.
- You want extra features, such as warranties or purchase protection.

Understanding Home Loans.

Fixed-Rate vs. Adjustable-Rate Mortgages.

When shopping for a mortgage, there are many important things to consider. One of the choices you'll have to make is whether to apply for a fixed-rate or an adjustable-rate mortgage. Knowing what type of home loan best fits your needs is key to a successful home-buying process.



Fixed-Rate Mortgage:

This program typically offers 10-, 15-, 20- and 30-year terms, and the interest rate remains the same for the life of the loan.



Each month's principal and interest payment is the same from the first to the last payment, which makes managing your monthly budget easier.

A Fixed-Rate Mortgage might be right for you if:

- You plan on staying in your home for many years.
- You want flexibility in choosing the term of the loan.
- You want the stability of the same monthly principal and interest payment.



Adjustable-Rate Mortgage:

This program typically offers a 30-year term, and there is an initial fixed-rate period — generally 3, 5, 7, or 10 years — after which the interest rate on the loan adjusts (may go up or down) periodically based on a set calculation disclosed by the lender. With each adjustment, the mortgage payment is recalculated. There are limits to the amount the interest rate can adjust from one period to the next, and over the life of the loan.

Kev benefit:

The initial interest rate and payment are generally lower than that of a comparable fixed-rate mortgage.

An Adjustable-Rate Mortgage might be right for you if:

- You don't plan to stay in your home for an extended period of time.
- You anticipate an increase in income over time.
- You are willing to risk a higher future interest rate for lower payments now.







